1. **HSE Plan & Compliance:** Developing, implementing, and maintaining an HSE plan, policies, and procedures in line with regulations and standards.

7. **Safety Reporting:** Preparing weekly/monthly safety reports, daily observation reports, issuing NCRs (Non-Conformance Reports) to subcontractors, and maintaining other safety documentation.
8. **Safety Meetings & Coordination:** Participating in weekly safety meetings, site safety walks, and coordination meetings with stakeholders.
9. **Emergency Response Plans (ERP):** Ensuring ERP efficiency through mock drills, team training, and preparedness.
10. **Fire Safety & Access:** Ensuring firefighting equipment is functional and access/egress points are clearly marked and lit.
11. **Lifting & Equipment Coordination:** Coordinating with logistics for crane/lifting gear certification and ensuring equipment inspections are up-to-date.
12. **COSHH Compliance:** Ensuring COSHH materials are stored per requirements, assessments are done, and staff are trained.
13. **HSE Team Management:** Managing and leading the HSE team to execute the safety programs and procedures effectively.
14. **MEP Coordination:** Coordinating with the MEP department to ensure that power tools and electrical equipment are tested, tagged, and in safe working condition.
